MEMORANDUM

Date: 26 May 2021

The Naval District Washington Fraternal Order of Police Labor Committee (NDW-FOP) is presenting this proposal to the Agency, Commander Naval Region Naval District Washington (NDW), to negotiate for the GS-7 Level for Police Officers. The NDW-FOP feels that this is also an attempt to assist the Agency in their budgetary concerns. These GS-7 personnel will not be designated as Sergeants and will wear the corporal stripes with a star beneath it. This will be classified as a lead Police Officer. This would become effective October 1, 2021.

All GS-6 Officers who were Grandfather in under the Navy Law Enforcement Program prior to 2011 will immediately be moved to the GS-7 level after completing the following.

1. Complete all Department Navy Police Requirements.
2. Complete all Required P.Q.S. Courses to include Patrol Supervisor.

All newly hired Officers hired at the GS-6 level must have completed the following prior to obtaining the GS-7 Level.

1. Complete the Uniform Police Training Program Course at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC).
2. Complete all required P. Q. S. Courses to include Patrol Supervisor.
3. Serve a two-year probationary period during this time.

All Officers hired at the GS-5 Level must complete the following before obtaining the GS-7 Level.

1. Complete the Uniform Police Training Program at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC).
2. Complete all required P.Q. S. Courses to include

Patrol Supervisor.

3. Serve a two-year probationary period during this time.

All Officers hired at the GS-4 Level will have to compete the progressive steps of GS 4,5, and 6 before obtaining the GS-7 Level.

1. Complete the Uniform Police Training Program at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC).
2. Complete all required P.Q.S Courses To include the Patrol Supervisor.
3. Serve a two-year probationary period during this time.

The NDW-FOP is also proposing that all current GS-7 Sergeants be moved to the GS-8 Level as Patrol Sergeants, provided they have completed all necessary P.Q.S. programs.
